 - Not spending money on Village road now until Tyrell addresses the gondola and large hotel b/c that will interrupt Village road
 - Drainage improvement is part of the project
 - Also- funding our sedimentation remediation programs
 - Question on page 63 about being tastefully designed and built.
 - Question about Abenaki tribe living here for thousands of years. Hastings think they
 just passed through. Take specific tribes out of the plan-just reference Indigenous.

 - Rebecca has been researching. Arbor day, Earth Day week, involve Rey Center etc.
 - Include native plants and tree list with planning board, to communicate to developers
