The meeting was called to order at 3:01 pm by Jennie Lucas

Attendance: Jennie Lucas, member; Charles Hastings, member; Rebecca Hastings, member; John Recine, ex-officio; Mark DeCoteau, Town Manager; Alisha Harrington, Town Administrator

The purpose of this meeting was to review engineering plans for a Wetland Permit Application regarding construction of the interim transfer station.

- Mark distributed copies of the engineering plans and explained that as part of the interim transfer station construction, an approximately 100-foot section of a current open-air stream is proposed to be enclosed in a new 36-inch underground culvert. This culvert would begin near one end of existing culvert (that runs beneath Tecumseh Rd.) and would empty into an existing wetland area at the stream's current terminus.
- This culvert will permit construction of a new access road to the interim transfer station, and other required infrastructure (fence, etc.).
- This will not impact the nearby condominiums.
- Charles motioned that we authorize the Conservation Commission chair, Irit Levy, and Mark to prepare a letter of support for the engineering plan. Becca seconded. The motion was approved unanimously.

Becca motioned to nominate Jennie Lucas as Vice Chair of the Conservation Commission. John seconded. The motion was approved, three in favor, Jennie abstained.

The meeting was adjourned at 3:20 pm.
