Master Plan Revision

"We are located on N'dakinna, which is the traditional ancestral homeland of the Abenaki, Pennacook, and Wabanaki Peoples, past and present. We acknowledge and honor with gratitude the land and waterways and the alnobak (people) who have stewarded N'dakinna throughout the generations."

The Board discussed if the statement should be included in the Master Plan, with some Board members feeling that the phrase "past and present" should be removed. The Board decided to table the discussion until the statement could be reviewed.

The Planning Board then reviewed and made edits to each section in chapter four of the Master Plan and reviewed and made suggestions to the action plan.

The Town Core Group continues to plan a signage system to help direct bikers from the bike shop over to the north end of town. The goal is to have them in place for the summer.

Conservation Commission
