Put into BLUE dumpsters:

Please empty & rinse all food containers. Please flatten all items as much as possible.
Newspapers/magazines/wrapping & tissue paper/ brown bags / egg cartons /
Catalogs / telephone books
Books - soft & hard cover
Junk mail (staples are OK) / envelopes / stickers / decals
Cereal / cracker / shoe boxes (please flatten)
Boxes (please flatten) - shipping (tape is OK) / cardboard poster / corrugated
Cartons - milk / juice (empty & rinsed)
Tubs - yogurt / cottage cheese / margarine / sour cream (empty & rinsed)
Plastic bottles - soda / juice / water (unscrew caps and toss in loose)
Rings of plastic that hold soda / juice / water
Twisty ties / bag fasteners / bottle caps (metal & plastic)
Plastic Jugs - milk / OJ / ketchup / salad dressing / bleach / detergent / shampoo
Glass jars & bottles - wine (toss caps & corks in loose)
Clean aluminum foil / pie plates / trays
Aluminum beer & soda cans / tin cans (empty & rinsed)
Steel picture frames / wire / EMPTY aerosol cans
Wicker baskets / string / rope
Rubber - mouse pads/erasers
Pens / pencils / markers
Plastic that bends (flexes when you push on it) - containers #1-7 (look on the bottom)
 Plastic egg cartons, cookie/cracker trays, tape dispensers
 Milk / soda crates
 Plastic plant pots / landscape trays
 Laundry baskets
 Bins (up to 5 gal.)
 Buckets (up to 5 gal.) - handles OK
 Kitty litter buckets (empty)
 Fold-up pools (children's size)

TRASH - put into GREEN dumpsters

Plastic bags / frozen food pouches
Wrappers/stretch wrap-bread/candy/cheese
Packing popcorn/styrofoam cups/meat trays
Mesh fruit bags
Wax paper-cereal box liners/butter wrapper
Metal CDs / VCR tapes / small tools
Hard (no bend) plastic/DVD jewel cases/toys
Ribbon / clothing/blankets/yarn/carpet/rugs
Dishes / ceramics / terra cotta pots
Candles / film/artificial plants/ paint brushes
Window glass / mirrors / eyeglasses
Smear paint on rags/cardboard - dry & dispose
